



## 'Batik Wheels' Supply List

Batik Wheels is a perfect quilt for using up all of those Fat Quarters you've been collecting! The only 'rule' per se, is keep in mind you need to have contrast. Take a look at the quilts above, and you'll see what I mean...matchy matchy gets lost on spikes, so keep that in mind when choosing fabrics.

For both of these quilts, I used FQ collections of 24 FQ in each collection. There was plenty of choice in both to come up with quilts that worked! So have fun with your selections!

### Fabric Requirements

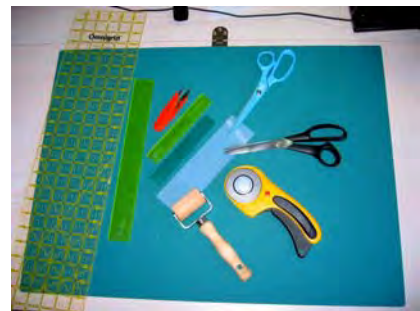
Quilt body: 24 Fat Quarters (and yes...you'll have leftover fabric, but you'll have the selection needed to get the desired effect)

Quilt Border: 1 Yard solid(ish) background (shown in dark green on one; hot pink on the other)

Quilt Border (Spikes) for the one on the left I used scraps from the quilt; the one on the right I used a Yard of lime green)

### Basic Supply List

Sewing Machine	Ironing matt if using an iron
90/14 Topstitch needles	Scissors, Thread Snips
¼" Presser foot w/Lip	Fabric!
Neutral Thread	A bag for your garbage
Flat head pins	Tape to tape the bag
Cutting Matt	12" or larger cutting ruler
Rotary Cutter w/sharp blade	Scotch tape (optional)
Add a Quarter ruler	Spray Starch-(I recommend Mary Ellen's Best Press)
Seam Presser or iron
